Awarded to a student entering Year 1 of the Western-Fanshawe Collaborative Nursing program, based on academic achievement (minimum 70% average) and financial need. This award will continue in Years 2, 3 and 4 of the recipient's Nursing program provided that the student maintains a 70% average and demonstrates financial need each year. If any recipient fails to qualify to continue receiving the award, another student from the same year will be selected as a replacement. Candidates must complete an admission bursary application that will be available in January of the year they apply for admission into Western. Applications for students in the Western stream of the Collaborative program can be accessed online through Student Center. Paper applications for students in the Fanshawe stream of the Collaborative program will be available for download through the Registrar's Web site.

Value: 2 at \$2,200, continuing for 4 years
